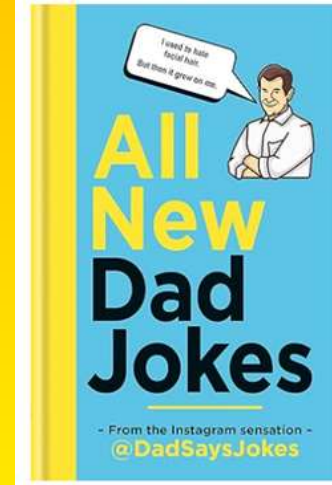
Meeting Wednesday 11th June 2025

“Cold drink” - 2 Photos

Please submit only 2 photos !

This challenge is all about making your drinks look attractive. Imagine you are shooting images for a glossy magazine. **To make it harder, please submit 1 x Portrait Orientation and 1 x Landscape Orientation.**

You will need to control what appears next to your drink – hint use shallow depth of field/focus to blur distractions. Try misting the glass to make it look cooler !

There are 4 categories – You can enter 1, 2 or more categories, but only 1 photo per category

(Challenge runs during all of June)

The categories are...

- 1) **Human World** - any photo with a person, or where the subject has been created by a person or persons.
- 2) **Natural World** - any photo where the subject is from the natural world, including landscapes.
- 3) **Monochrome** - any photo in a single colour, or black and white, of any subject.
- 4) **Close-up** - any photo where you have focussed on part of an object.

Monochrome

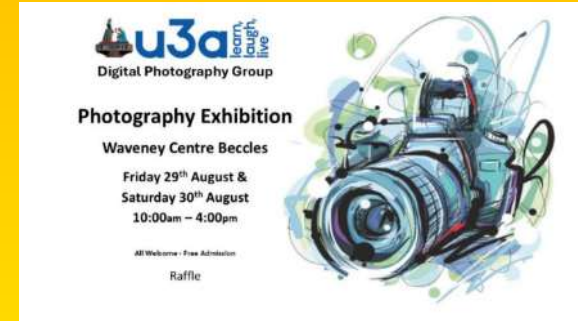
Close-up

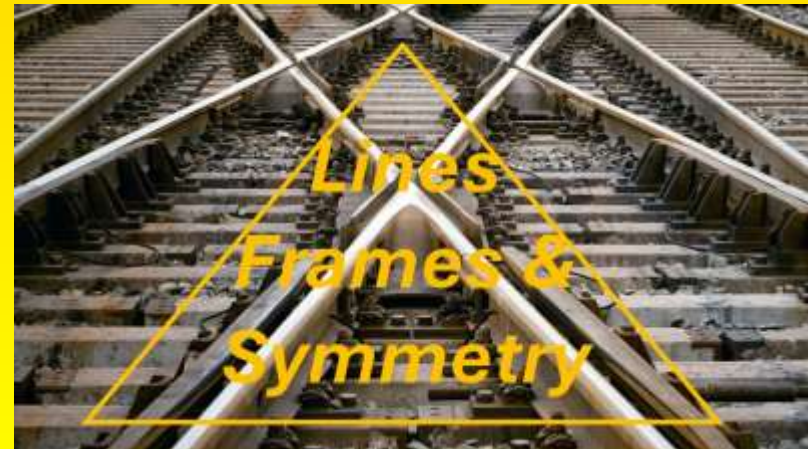
