Small car park opposite museum in Blackfriars, also NR30 3BX

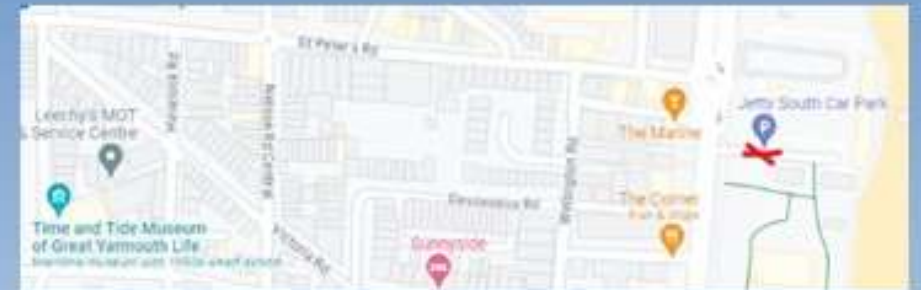
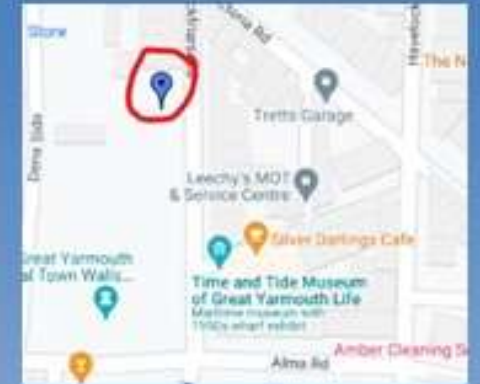
