The Five Challenges

- **Search in Unlikely Places** — Explore alleys, thrift stores, beaches, or forgotten corners to find overlooked objects with interesting textures or shapes.
- **Isolate Your Subject** — Use a simple background (paper, fabric, clean surface) to remove distractions and emphasise detail and texture.
- **Experiment with Angles** — Shoot from top-down, side-on, or unusual viewpoints to reveal patterns or features you might otherwise miss.
- **Play with Lighting** — Use natural or artificial light to highlight texture and depth. Side or diffused lighting works especially well.
- **Create a Narrative** — Arrange objects to tell a story or evoke a mood. Grouping related items can create nostalgia or intrigue.



Your Found Object Challenge

- Find an everyday object.
- Observe it closely.
- Photograph it with intention — angle, light, background, narrative.
- Transform the ordinary into something extraordinary.

This challenge is designed to:

- Encourage fresh ways of seeing
- Build creative discipline
- Help photographers find inspiration anywhere
- Turn ordinary objects into expressive visual stories
